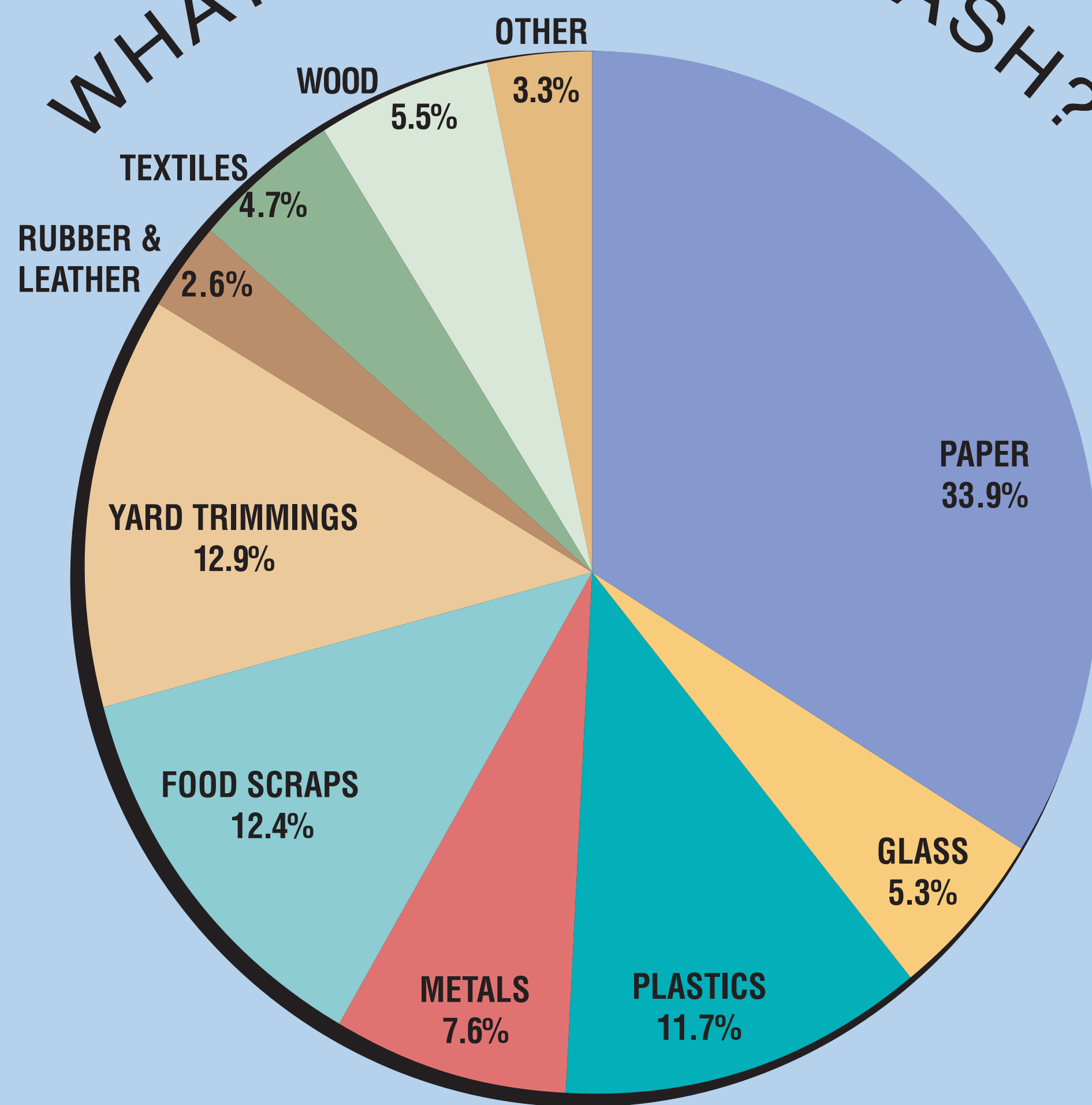


WHAT'S IN YOUR TRASH?



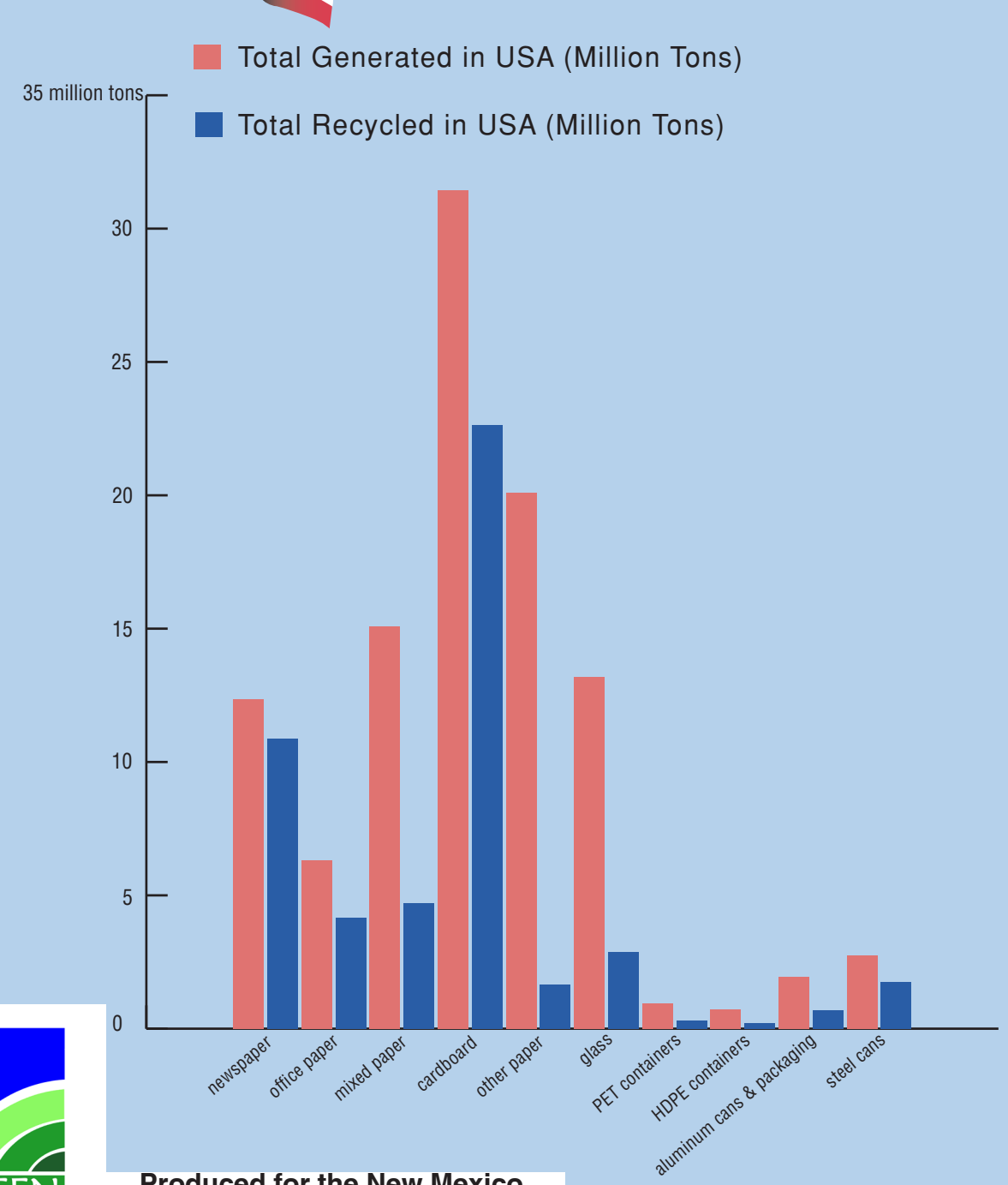
- RUBBER AND LEATHER**
 - tires
 - other rubber products including carpet
 - clothing and shoes
 - other leather products
- FOOD SCRAPS**
 - waste food from stores, restaurants and homes
- YARD TRIMMINGS**
 - grass
 - leaves
 - tree and shrub prunings
- TEXTILES**
 - fleece
 - flannel
 - wool
 - nylon
 - denim, etc
- WOOD**
 - building materials
 - forestry waste
 - non-residential trees and shrubs
- OTHER**
 - all other unidentified materials

- PAPER**
 - newspaper
 - junk mail
 - office paper
 - cardboard and paperboard
 - phone books
 - magazines and catalogs
 - books
 - all products made from paper
- GLASS**
 - glass bottles and jars
 - other glass from appliances, furniture etc
- METALS**
 - aluminum cans and other goods
 - steel cans and all other steel products
 - copper
 - brass
 - all other metals
- PLASTICS**
 - Bottles and other products made from plastic like toys, car parts and furniture.
 - Plastics are identified by number as follows:
 - #1 PET
 - #2 HDPE
 - #3 PVC
 - #4 LDPE
 - #5 PP
 - #6 PS
 - #7 Other

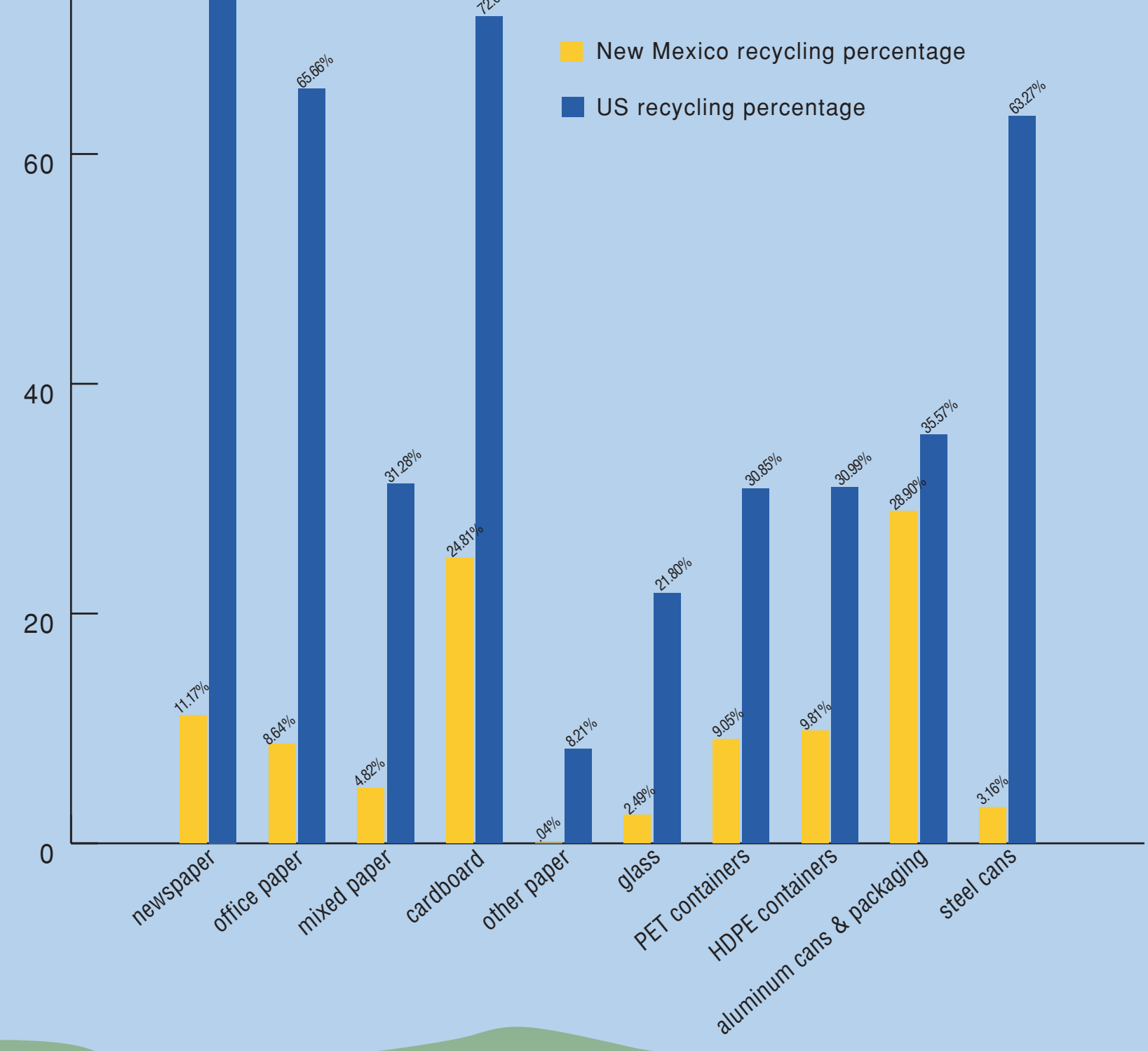
