














We partner with local businesses to provide the opportunity for them to recycle the glass waste that they produce as byproducts of their own products and businesses.

What happens to the bottles'

Broken Arrow Glass upcycles the bottles into drinking glasses for the brewery. How closed loop can you get?

Together we set up a bottle return mission for the business. This allows the business to give incentives to their customers to return the empty bottles to the brewery and then at the same time this gets the customer back into the brewery to buy more product. Growth happens at the same time for both the partnership business and the bottle return mission.

Then we collect the glass waste from the brewery and bring it back to our studio to turn the bottles into second life products.













PRODUCTS

How much are we Diverting?

- We upcycle about 400 bottles a month by turning bottles into drinking glasses, vases, jars, lighting, and terrazzo.
- We process about 4 tons of glass bottles a month by crushing the glass into raw material. We then sift this material into three different sizes; sand, cullet, and paper labels. This material is used for landscaping, eco-construction, flood diversion, and raw art material.
- Once we start melting the bottles down and blowing with bottle glass, we expect to upcycle 2,000–5,000 bottles a month through our glassblowing program. These numbers can grow as we can build more equipment and begin offering glassblowing classes with bottle glass.
