### Re-use Area **Policy and Operating Plan**Purpose: Divert usable items from the landfill.


- 1. Cut transportation cost
- 2. Tipping fee
- 3. Saving space & extending life of landfill
- 4. Giving customers useful items at no cost

#### Operational Policies:

- 1. EVSWA has final decision managing re-use area
- 2. Re-use area, not a dumping area or charitable site. This area also requires payment stub or window decal.
- 3. Items should be clean, usable or re-pairable
- 4. EVSWA has the prerogative: a. Allows Customer to acquire items
  - b. Give to charitable agency
  - c. Send to Landfill

#### **EVSWA**

- 1. Would like people to see if Bethel Community Store House would like it first. They have a store house which uses the money to buy food to give to low income families.
- 2. One day a week sort through items to be sent to landfill. Items should only remain about two weeks.
- 3. When attendants are inspecting a load they may suggest to customers to put item in swap shop.




#### Notice

You do have to monitor the swap shop so things won't get out of hand. Customers dropping off (junk) or some customers taking more than they should. We allow customers to take two items per week per customer.
